

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT VOYAGER STRUCTURED PLAY

To play in a structured play session, sign your name on the signup sheet prior to the start time of that session. The sheet will be located on or near the fence or storage bin next to Court #6. You must sign yourself in. Latecomers will be turned away. Only players who signed in on time may play in that session.

Players are expected to stay for the entire session. Players can “share a number”, playing every other game, in any of the Partner Switch sessions.

Courts that are not needed for a Structured Play session will be released for Open Play within 10 minutes after the scheduled start time.

During all Structured Play, please refrain from giving other players unsolicited advice regarding their play. Also, please do not tell other players what skill level group they belong in, unless specifically asked.

Each session is coordinated by a Structured Play Volunteer. Please remember to thank them.

Anyone able to volunteer to be a Mentor for Novice Play, please contact John Van Dam, the Structured Play Committee Chair, or Priscilla Scott, Pickleball Coordinator. Volunteers receive a short training and are very much appreciated by the Novice players. It's fun and rewarding, and a great way to give back to our awesome pickleball community.
